Position Classification: Weekly/Seasonally
Supervisor: Program Director

Position Summary: Counselors enjoy the most individual contact with children, youth and families, at camp. Counselors supervise between four to twelve campers each week. Living in rustic cabins, tree houses and tents, counselors are responsible for the daily activities of the cabin group.

Primary Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to communicate with all ages
- Willingness to be a positive role model for children
- Ability to work well with others
- Openness to being spontaneous, enthusiastic and willing to learn
- Positive attitude in working with all types of staff and campers

Personal Qualifications:

- Being 18 years of age, or having completed one year of college
- Having a personal faith in Christ and a willingness to share your faith with others
- Willingness to teach and learn from children, youth, and adults
- Having a genuine interest in people—relating positively to and listening to individuals

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Setting an example of Christian living at all times
- Being responsible for the safety, supervision, and care of campers
- Listening and responding appropriately to campers
- Helping plan and lead camp activities—daily activities may include: Team building, Bible studies, recreation options, cooking some meals over fires, leading songs and worship
- Work in a variety of program areas based largely on counselor preferences throughout the summer.
- Working on-site programs, off-site adventure programs/mission service trips, and day camp programs in churches; as well as in the Kitchen or with Maintenance when necessary
- Fulfilling all other duties as appointed by the Program Director or Executive Directors
